## COURSE OUTLINE

The WJEC Eduqas Drama GCSE course offers a challenging and stimulating environment in which to study, where students are positively encouraged to broaden their performance and group work skills in a safe and secure environment.

## HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

The course has key areas of study in which students develop a range of acting and reflective evaluation skills. These include:

- Creation and performance of a piece of devised drama, including a written course work log (40%).
- Study and performance of two extracts from a scripted play text (20%).
- Written exam analysing and evaluating a set text and a live theatrical performance (40%).

## WHAT SKILLS DO I NEED?

At the start of the Drama GCSE course you need nothing other than the desire to further develop your performance techniques and confidence, as well as a willingness to work hard whilst doing so in a group environment. Students should not choose Drama if they do not like performing, or are not willing to develop their levels of confidence in this area.
