Y10 BATTLEFIELDS HISTORY TRIP (THU 11 - SAT 13 JULY 2019)

We are arranging a visit to the Battlefields in Ypres in Belgium and the Somme in France for History students in current Year 10. This will take place between Thursday 11 July and Saturday 13 July 2019. The cost of the trip will be £300pp; this includes all transportation, two night's accommodation, breakfast on two days and two evening meals plus entrance to the museums. We are also including a visit to Disneyland on the final day.

The students will be travelling by coach, leaving the academy on Thursday 11 July (timings will be confirmed nearer the date); we will travel to Belgium and France, returning to the academy late on Saturday night. It is essential that all students have a valid Passport and a European Health Insurance Card.

Visits play an important part in the learning of our students and we understand the financial demands placed on parents resulting from our school activities, which is why this trip is not a compulsory part of our curriculum. It is intended to extend the student's understanding of significant events in our history as well as to develop their knowledge of World War One medicine and surgery. If we do receive insufficient interest or contributions to make this trip financially viable, it will be cancelled and any deposit returned.

In order for your child to participate, we require online parental consent and payment of the deposit via ParentPay. If you do not have a ParentPay account then you can request one by emailing data@westbourne.atrust.org.uk. Alternatively, your child can collect a printed consent form and Paypoint barcode from the Finance Office window before school. A deposit of £60 is required to secure a place on the trip. The deadline for payment of the deposit is Wednesday 31 October 2018. All future installments will need to be paid either online via ParentPay or by PayPoint at the local Coop. We regret that we can no longer accept cash or cheque payments. There is space for a maximum of 40 pupils on the trip and places will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Payment is required in full before the trip departs and the instalments are as follows:

We will be carrying a first aid kit and at least one member of staff accompanying the visit is a qualified first aider.

You are advised that the academy's school trip insurance policy will cover your child for this trip abroad and fuller details will be provided once your child's place has been confirmed. You should also be aware that the academy reserves the right to withdraw a place on the trip for any student whose attitude, attendance, behaviour, conduct or punctuality falls below the standard we expect and require of our students.



ITINERARY OUTLINE

Day One: You will need a packed lunch for your journey out to Ypres. Once there, visiting Ypres town, Hooge Crater and trench system museum, Tyne Cot cemetery and the Menin Gate, dinner is included.

Day Two: Arras tunnels, Thiepval Memorial, Lochnager Crafter and Newfoundland Park. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

Day Three: A day in Disneyland Paris. Breakfast and lunch included

We very much hope that your child is able to come on the trip. It is an excellent programme that we have hosted for many years and they will find it very educationally rewarding and enjoyable.
