This initiative is designed to enable you to follow your AS & A level education, to receive high quality football coaching at Kesgrave High School and become part of Leiston Football Club.



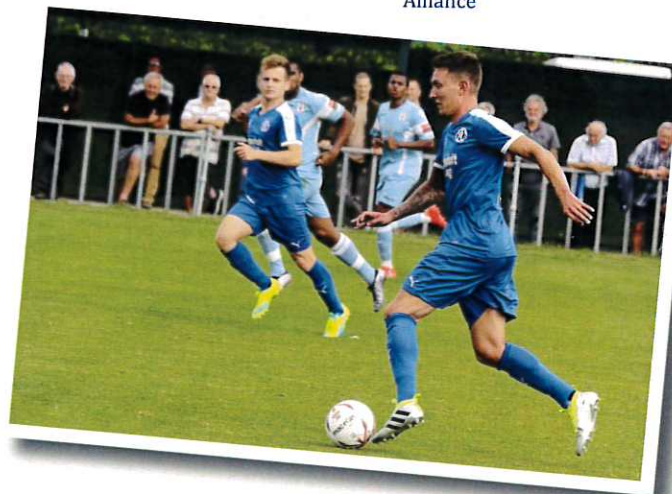

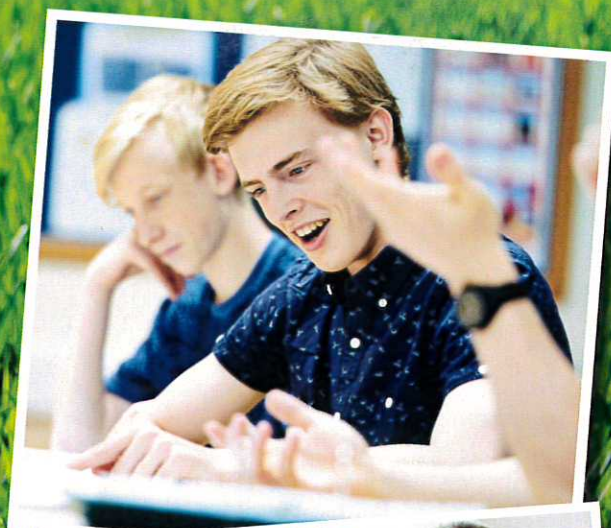
