

## PRESS RELEASE 23 AUGUST 2018 YEAR 11 EXAM RESULTS

Another pleasing year of improvements in results for pupils at Westbourne Academy. Headline figures in maths and English compare well to national figures. It is particularly pleasing that there were thirteen students who achieved the challenging level 9 in mathematics. Out of a cohort of 184 students, 63% achieved a level 4 or above in English and maths compared to 58% in 2017.
