In preparation for the start of your GCSE course in September we would like you to produce three pages of work for your coursework folder. These should be presented on the paper provided to you (20x20cm). These can then be presented in your sketchbook in September. Please bring them with you for your first GCSE Art lesson in September

**Description of the task**

**Task 1:** Take about 5-6 photographs of local graffiti. Present them on your page and add a creative title (This could be a collage from magazine letters for example) Make notes about the photographs explaining why you took them, where they were and what they are of and about. In the spaces add drawings from the photographs in appropriate media. Be creative.



**Task 2:** To create a page of drawings based on famous buildings, landmarks and structures from around the world as well as in your local area. This page should include a range of drawings in different media such as paint, pencil, pencil crayon or biro. Try to draw at least one local building from life. Include relevant information in note form about what you have drawn, what media you have used and the shape and style of each building. This page should include 2 -3 studies as a minimum.



**Task 3:** To create a drawing of a skyline FROM LIFE or from a photograph that you have taken. An excellent place for you to draw would be the Ipswich Docks. Use the media of your choice to create a line and tone drawing. This might be pencil, biro, fine liner etc. The drawing should be created along the bottom of this page only as this page will be added to and developed further in lesson in September.
